LEAVING A LEGACY

The gift of a legacy in your will to your favourite Charity is an enduring memorial which will help make it possible for The Mark Davies Injured Riders Fund to help injured riders for generations to come.

People usually write their wills at particular milestones in their life, for example, when they marry, have children, or retire and it is very simple to add a codicil to your Will at any time to create a lasting gift of your choice.

To include The Mark Davies Injured Fund in your Will you would be advised to speak to a solicitor who will know about wording the bequest correctly within legal requirements.

If your estate is subject to Inheritance Tax, it is worth bearing in mind that your bequest may be exempt from tax, so that your generosity becomes even more beneficial.
